



TLP Training Course



Course Material Content Outline

Each module consists of course work plus four study reports that have to be completed over the following two months. The study reports are based on the course work and also on real visits to factories and businesses to actually see the processes in operation. Real issues studied during these visits form the subjects of the reports.

In the last module the four study reports are replaced by a dissertation topic which is determined at the time and are related to real time South African business and industrial development.

Technology Leadership Programme

The course covers one year of continuous involvement, including four one-week Interact Periods at a live-in venue.

During the sectors between interact periods, the candidates' work on tasks and case studies. The workload is therefore continuous throughout the year. This results in a continuous learning experience.

The Curriculum is concerned with a holistic approach, and is configured into five categories: Technology, Economics, Human Resources Issues, Finance and Business Practice, and Marketing.

A series of Target Competencies and New Mindsets is defined within this framework.

All learning interventions are directed towards consolidating these competencies and mindsets.

The Technology Leadership Programme is aimed at taking young professionals and exposing them to real world management and real situations.

This type of training has now become commonly known as "Action Learning."

TLP spans a year of part time study and interaction. TLP has no exams to write, instead assessment is carried out by means of a significant number of projects and tasks based on study visits to real companies. Candidates get their hands dirty, they do not only retrieve academic material from the literature.

Candidates live in at the conference venue. This is because evenings are occupied with guest speaker dinners, study groups, and student presentations.

The TLP course has been rated as being NQF level 6 with a weighting of 120 credits.

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
